







# **ENTRY TACTICS**

#### FIVE WAYS TO INITIATE TRADES USING HIDDEN PIVOTS

- 1. Conventional: The subtlety of the ABC pattern is crucial
- 2. Camouflage: Best way to minimize risk, but labor-intensive
- 3. Counterintuitive: Easiest trade for a novice to learn and use
- 4. Mechanical: Biggest initial risk, but you can relax thereafter
- 5. Timed buy- or sell-stop: When in doubt, a good way to test the water



#### MECHANICAL ENTRIES: NOTHING TO DECIDE!


- 1. If an ABC pattern exceeds x, p or p2 decisively but doesn't reach D (or the next level), we should look to initiate trades on a touch-and-go retracement back to x, p or p2. Look for 'white space' and at least three bars of hovering before entering.
- 2. Use a stop-loss equal to 1/3 of the potential gain, assuming the trend is to reach 'D' or the next Hidden Pivot level.

The mechanical trade is ideal when we're confident a target will be reached. It is the simplest way to get aboard and takes advantage of the fact that a C-D leg that has decisively exceeded its p midpoint or p2 'secondary pivot' is likely to reach its target. Risk management is also mechanical, since it utilizes a fixed 1-to-3 risk:reward ratio.



#### **GRADING THE TRADE - BEFORE AND AFTER**

#### PRE-ENTRY

- 1-5: < 50% odds getting from x to p
- 6-7: Successful ride to p likely
- 8-9: Very likely ride to D: a winner!
- 10: A "What-r-u-waiting-for?" trade

#### POST-MORTEM

- A No sweat. Hit x and took off.
- B Slight anxiety. Hit x, corrected a tad.
- B- Some stress. Hit x, fell halfway to C.
- C- Real pain. Hit x, pulled back to C.
- D Strain and pain. Pounded on C.
- F An ordeal. Pounded C for an eternity.
